## Launching Lives of Purpose

NDNU's Preliminary Administrative Services Credential and Master of Arts in School Administration is a 30 - unit integrated program. The program includes courses in leadership, management, finance, human resources, curriculum development, and assessment. Administration field work is embedded in coursework to allow candidates to apply course content in "real life" school administration responsibilities.

## DISTINCTIONS OF THE M.A. SCHOOL ADMIN PROGRAM

- Complete your Preliminary Administrative Services Credential and Masters in a 30 -unit five semester program that begins each fall and meets year round
- Cohort classes meet two evenings a week to meet the needs of adult students who are working in districts/ schools during the day



## Graduate Programs that Transform Careers.

Applicants to the program must hold a valid preliminary or clear teaching, designated subjects, or services credential; meet the California basic skills requirement; have a minimum of 3-years of classroom teaching or experience in a service area field; introductory courses in Psychology and Sociology or complete courses by mid-program; interview with the Administrative Services Program Director.

The Masters in School Administration and the Preliminary Admin Services Credential requires 30 semester units of study.
