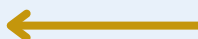

This program focuses on curriculum and instruction, with four courses designed to enhance skills in curriculum development and assessment.

Distinctions of the Program

- Candidates used action research as the foundation for their master's thesis, allowing the opportunity to investigate in depth a particular area of curriculum and instruction within their own classroom or school
- Credentialed teachers can transfer up to 6-units of graduate level coursework not applied to another degree
