Graduate Programs that Transform Careers

Applicants must have a valid teaching or service credential, meet the California basic skills requirement, and have 3+ years of experience. Introductory courses in Psychology and Sociology are required, or must be completed mid-program. An interview with the Program Director is also required.

Distinctions of the Program

- Complete your Preliminary Administrative Services Credential and Masters in a 30-unit five semester program that begins each fall and meets year round
- Cohort classes meet two evenings a week to meet the needs of adult students who are working in districts/schools during the day
- Credentialed teachers can transfer up to 6-units of graduate level coursework not applied to another degree

Admissions Requirements

- Completion of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution
- Submission of a completed application
- Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended
- Current résumé or curriculum vitae (CV)
- Two letters of recommendation (academic and/or professional)
- Statement of Intent outlining your interest in this program, relevant experience, and professional goals
- Interview with the Program Director
