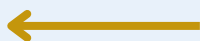

## Graduate Programs that Transform Careers

Work with special education students in K-12 settings and up to age 22, focusing on mild/moderate support needs (MMSN) or extensive support needs (ESN).

The program covers diverse settings including resource rooms, special education settings, general education settings, special schools, home/hospital settings, and more! Candidates gain proficiency in critical knowledge, assessment, and specialized instruction.

## Distinctions of the Program

- Students complete the 44-unit credential and add the Master of Arts (MA) in Special Education by taking one 3-unit capstone course
- General education teachers can add the special education credential with a master's degree by taking 30 units
- Faculty bring diverse academic and practical expertise teachers and administrators in public and private schools into their advising and instruction

## Admissions Requirements

- Completion of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution
- Submission of a completed application
- Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended
- Current résumé or curriculum vitae (CV)
- Two letters of recommendation (academic and/or professional)
- Statement of Intent outlining your interest in this program, relevant experience, and professional goals
- Interview with the Program Director

## Program Requirements

- CTC Certificate of Clearance (fingerprint clearance)
- Provide a copy of negative tb test result within last 2 years
- Provide verification of meeting the U.S. Constitution requirement by exam, course work, or CSU degree
- Complete CPR training for infant, child, and adult
- Personal interview with program director
