The Bachelor of Arts in Psychology Degree Completion Program provides a clear path to your degree for those with 45–78 credits from an accredited college or a university.

Distinctions of the Program

- Earn your degree after completing a combined 120 units
- The program costs \$412 per unit. For a 42-unit program, the total cost is \$17,304

Admissions Requirements

- GPA of 2.0 or above
 - Ability to transfer in a total of 78 units, with a minimum of 45 transferable units from other regionally accredited institutions
- Intro to Psych/General Psych
 - Pre-requisite, Can be taken during your first semester at NDNU, alongside upper division coursework
- Requirements may vary based on your previous institution, the transfer admissions counselor can help determine your eligibility.
